General Rate Increase (GRI)
US East Coast and US Gulf Coast to Europe, Mediterranean, Middle East Gulf,
Red Sea & Indian Subcontinent destinations - POSTPONED
Effective November 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customers,

Due to current market conditions, CMA CGM (America) will postpone the previously announced GRI to be effective November 1, 2011. This GRI covers export cargo moving from or via the US East Coast and the US Gulf Coast to all destinations in North Europe (Scandinavia, Baltic, UK, Ireland, Main European Continent), Mediterranean (West Med, Adriatic, Black Sea, East Med, North Africa), Red Sea, Middle East Gulf & Indian Subcontinent as follows:

USD \$150 per 20' container (all types)
USD \$200 per 40' container (all types)

This increase will be applied on all export shipments moving under tariff rates or service contracts for all types of cargo (dry, refrigerated or special equipment) upon receipt of cargo at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of November 1, 2011.
