Emergency Fuel Surcharge Revision  
USA to North Europe, Mediterranean,  
Middle East and Red Sea  
Effective October 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective **October 1, 2011**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will adjust the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) for all export cargo moving from all U.S. origins, East Coast, West Coast and Gulf to all destinations in North Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, East Mediterranean, West Mediterranean, Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Red Sea and Persian Gulf, as follows:

This charge will apply to all cargo received and moving under a CMA CGM bill of lading on or after October 1, 2011.
