Service Rotation Change – Gulf Bridge Express
Effective September 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **September 2011**, CMA CGM (America) LLC has decided to upgrade its fixed-day weekly GULF BRIDGE EXPRESS Service connecting US Gulf and Mexico to the Caribbean with the addition of direct calls in **New Orleans** in the US Gulf and **Puerto Cabello** in Venezuela; thus significantly broadening the scope of the service for our customers. The new Weekly rotation will begin with voyage GH269S / MV WEHR with Puerto Cabello ETA September 21st, 2011. The first New Orleans call will start on October 1st, 2011 with voyage GH275S / MV WOTAN.

The new rotation will be as follows: New Orleans (Wed) – Houston (Fri) – Altamira (Sun) – Vera Cruz (Mon) – Kingston (Fri) – Cartagena (Sun) – Puerto Cabello (Wed) – La Guaira (Sun) – Kingston (Fri).

Puerto Cabello now benefits from weekly, direct and fast connections from US Gulf, Mexico, Columbia and the Caribbean basin via Kingston. While New Orleans is now connected directly or by relay via Kingston to the Caribbean and the Central and South American markets. South bound and North bound calls in Kingston Hub allows for seamless relay to and from worldwide markets connecting to the CMA CGM global service network.
