**Customer Advisory #94 – 2011
UPDATED Congestion Surcharge
Tunis, Tunisia
Effective October, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Following latest Customer Advisory # 88 sent on August 25, 2011, related to Port of Tunis situation, please be advised that the congestion is getting further deteriorated as some of our vessels are now being delayed up to three weeks.

At this stage we do not see any sign of improvement as far as the forecasted operational situation is concerned. In order to recover part of the increasing costs related with this call, we will have to adjust the Tunis Port Congestion Surcharge from \$100/TEU to \$125/TEU.

Please note that the new surcharge will be applied on all shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of **October 6, 2011**.
