Libya Service Update - September**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that with the improving political situation in Libya this has led to a significant part of the sanctions being waived by the European Union on September 1st, 2011. The September 1st decision amends Council decision 2011/137/CFSP of February 28, 2011, which introduced a travel ban and an assets freeze, while granting the necessary humanitarian exemptions. This decision was published in the Official Journal of the EU on 09/02/11.

It is important to note that despite the ongoing war situation in Libya over the past months, CMA CGM has been able to maintain service to Libya via Malta with a total of 17 calls performed in Tripoli, Benghazi and Misurata, mainly with important aid and humanitarian cargo.

As a result of the lifting of sanctions by the European Union CMA CGM will gradually resume its full service to LIBYA from Malta and as a priority will clear the backlog of containers delayed at the transshipment port.

The next sailings to LIBYA will be as follows:

- MV "CC RABAT" - voyage KT185R ETA BENGHAZI Sept 7th 2011
- MV "OUED ZIZ" - voyage OZ336R ETA TRIPOLI Sept 12th 2011
- MV "CC RABAT" - voyage KT186R ETA TRIPOLI Sept 16th 2011
- MV "OUED ZIZ" - voyage KT337R ETA BENGHAZI Sept 21 – ETA MISURATA Sept 25th

Thereafter, CMA CGM will operate:

- 1x weekly service from Malta to Tripoli
- 1x 10 day service from Malta to Benghazi and Misurata.

Service to El Khoms will resume as soon as port conditions will allow safe operations.
